Update on Website:

Jack Mourad will set up a meeting with Mark Manning to discuss the next steps for the website and will also publish the hemorrhage/ maternal morbidity toolkits up on the website. This will be the first time that the MPQC will distribute and make available these toolkits to the general public via the website. The website continues to receive positive feedback.

Update on Next PI Cycle:

The Hypertension PI cycle confirmations: Plymouth, Anajakes, BID, Leominster, Tufts, BI, and Emerson. Having trouble with BMC, will contact Ron Iverson (Substance Abuse Chair) to receive guidance and help. Lowell might also be on board. 6 confirmed, 8 waiting. We need 10 confirmed and are awaiting further responses. We did not speak to the Brigham and will ask Audra Meadows (Preterm Labor Chair) for guidance.

We need to continue to engage hospitals, especially those who did not submit their data from the previous hemorrhage PI Cycle. A Lot of them were dealing with the rollout of EPIC and were having trouble getting data in on time. A group message and further communication is a must.

Those that have completed their data entry and PI Cycle for hemorrhage will present at the MPQC summit and will discuss challenges and obstacles that will help the Hypertension PI participants. They will present their findings and work.
