Toolkit production	<p>Carolyn-Castro Donlan has edited and drafted the SA toolkit. The toolkit has been distributed to the group for review.</p> <p>The group will send Colleen Labelle content and information so that this outline will start to provide substance. The group agrees that the document should remain a 'living document' and that every institution/hospital that will use the toolkit must tailor the content and information to their practice.</p> <p>Updates: The MPQC Maternal Opioid Use During Pregnancy took place on April 25th, 2016. There were over 40 participants. The toolkit was live with the direction of Carolyn. There was a lot of feedback that was received from the MPQC group. The toolkit will be a live document that will continuously become updated.</p>	All
Open Discussion	There is a need to include the street drug names into the toolkit. The MPQC group agrees these names would be useful. The group requested a way to estimate the amount of substance used in these street drugs. It is impossible to find an equivalent to the street drugs that are out there. Dosing is very hard to control.	All
