<p>Low Risk</p> <p>No previous uterine incision Singleton Pregnancy <5 previous vaginal births No known bleeding disorder No history of postpartum hemorrhage</p>	<p>Planning Steps</p> <p>No lab work or send clot</p>
<p>Medium Risk</p> <p>Prior Cesarean or Myomectomy Multiples 5 or more vaginal births Known Coagulopathy History of Previous Postpartum Hemorrhage Platelets <100,000 BMI > 40 Hematocrit <28.0</p>	<p>Planning Steps</p> <p>Send Type and Screen Alert Anesthesia</p>
<p>High Risk</p> <p>Placenta Previa Suspected Accreta/Percreta Active Vaginal Bleeding</p>	<p>Planning Steps</p> <p>Send Type and Cross Match (2 units) Alert Anesthesia Alert Blood Bank All care staff review Massive Transfusion Protocol</p>
<p>Intrapartum Risks</p> <p>Chorioamnionitis Suspected Placenta Abruptio Eclampsia Platelets <100,000</p>	<p>Planning Steps</p> <p>Send Type and Screen Alert Anesthesia</p>
